How to Complete the Assignment:

1. Click on the YouTube link to today's performance in the email I sent you today (Friday).

 - *Note: This video only contains the video of your performance of "St. Paul's Suite-Jig"*
2. Watch the video in full AT LEAST one time.
3. In Notability or any other notetaking or word processing app, open a blank document.
4. In the upper right hand corner of the document, type the following:
 - Your First and Last Name
 - Symphony Orchestra
 - Today's Date
5. At the top of the page, type the title "Symphony Orchestra – 10/17 Performance Reflection"
6. In paragraph form (not bullet points), answer the following questions:
 - **Paragraph 1:** Imagine you are in the role of an audience member listening to your performance. Describe your overall impression of the performance in all of the following areas:

Ensemble

Are we playing together and in sync?

Do the instruments and sections sound like one united sound?

Articulation

Can the audience tell that there are different articulations (accents, legato, staccato, etc.) in the music or does it all sound the same?

Expression/Dynamics

Is the performance moving? Do you feel an emotional connection to the performance based on what you hear?

- **Paragraph 2:** Choose 3 short sections (16 measures or less) that you think we should focus on in rehearsal and sectionals. Answer the following for each section:

1. Beginning and ending measure numbers of section
2. Which of the following music skills should be focused on in this section?

Notes/Rhythms

Intonation

Articulation

Balance/Blend/Ensemble

Expression/Dynamics

3. How would you rehearse this section in the orchestra or sectional setting?
